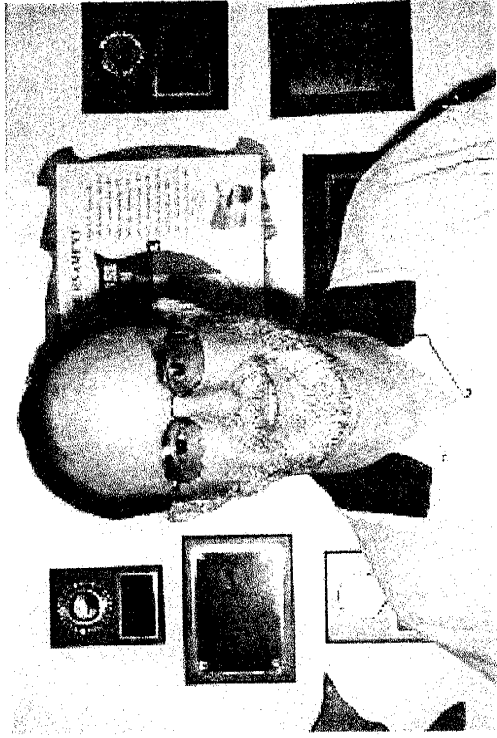

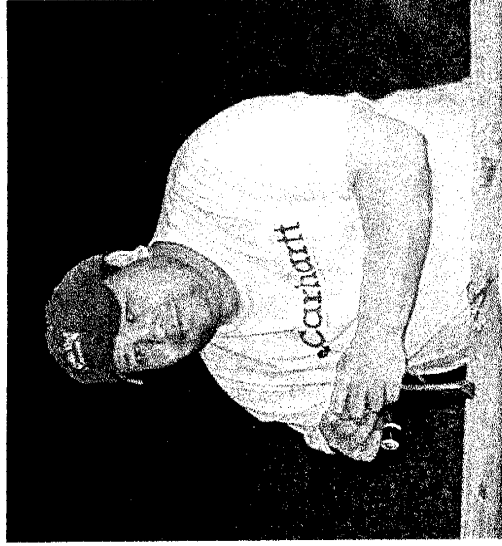

It has been a wonderful privilege for me to be involved with this group, in spite of my being first-timer attending NBAD as a "Rookie".

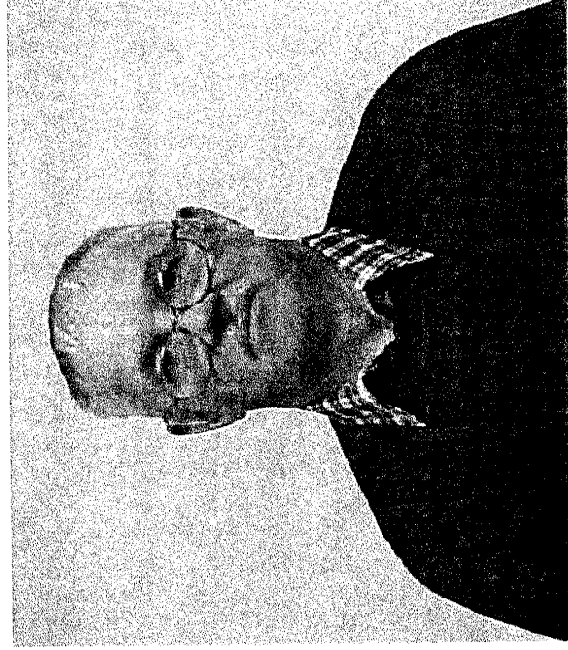
I believe that we will enjoy competing against each other and challenge of our catching big one, and swap our fishermen's stories.

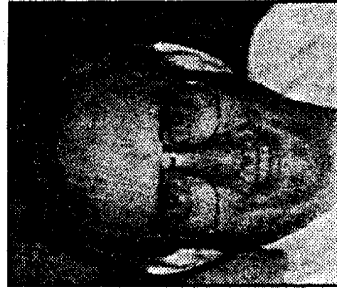

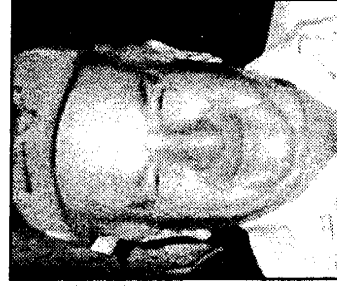

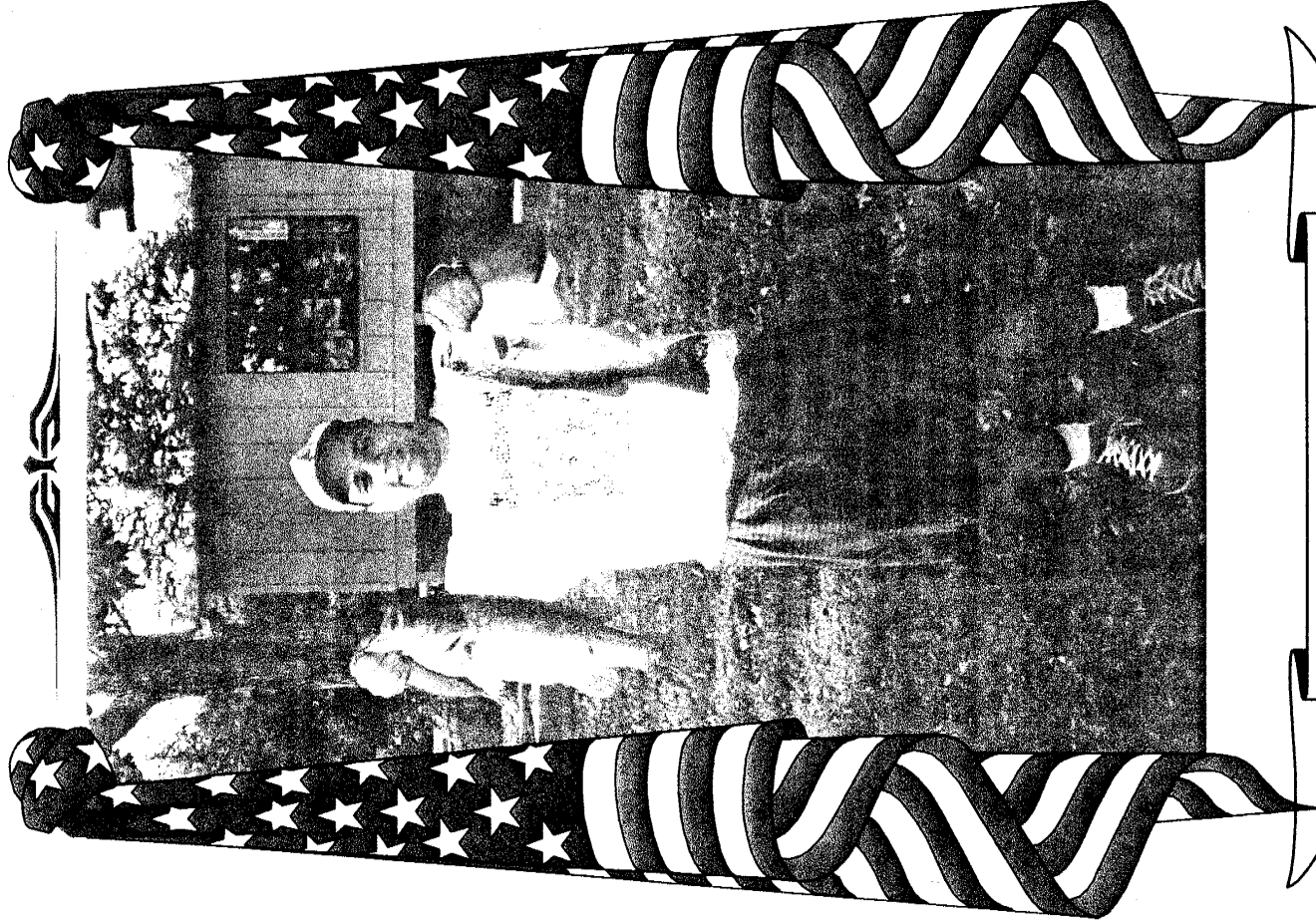

Tod Morris was born in Blue Island, Illinois on March 9, 1964. God baptized him as a infant at St. Michael Catholic Church in Orland Park, Il. He attended Elam Christian School for the Handicapped in Crestwood, IL. He transfered into a mainstream program in the Chicago Suburban schools, graduating from Hinsdale South High School, Darien, IL. In 1983. Beginning at North Central Institute for the Deaf in Rochester, NY, where he graduated with a degree in Electro-Mechanical Engineering (1988) continuing his studies at Rochester institute of Technology, he graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Packaging-Design Engineering (1991). Just before his death he received a Post-Bachelor degree from St. Louis University in Computer Science (2002).

He became a member of HIBASS in 1993 and was ranked 4th overall in the club for overall total weight in HIBASS history with a total of 104 lbs and 9 oz using a combined 47 tournament caught bass. He first attended the NBAD tournament in 1994 and has been to 5 of its tournaments since then.

HIBASS has decided to honor his memory by adding an award known as the Morris Cup, which is a floating trophy to be passed around to the annual winner, along with their name scribed onto it, based upon a point system that Tod has proposed just before his death. HIBASS thought it was a great point system and decided to name it after him.

Tod is survived by his wife, Cathy, and two children, Emily and Jason.

We, the members of HIBASS shall miss him tremendously as he was an outstanding person and fisherman.
