We are Looking for another 100 or more Teams this year since bad economy in past few years ago.

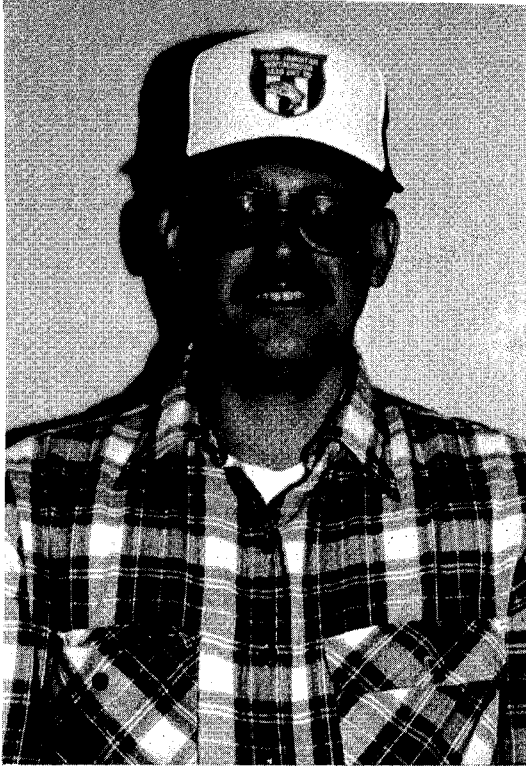
