An open letter to HBCD,

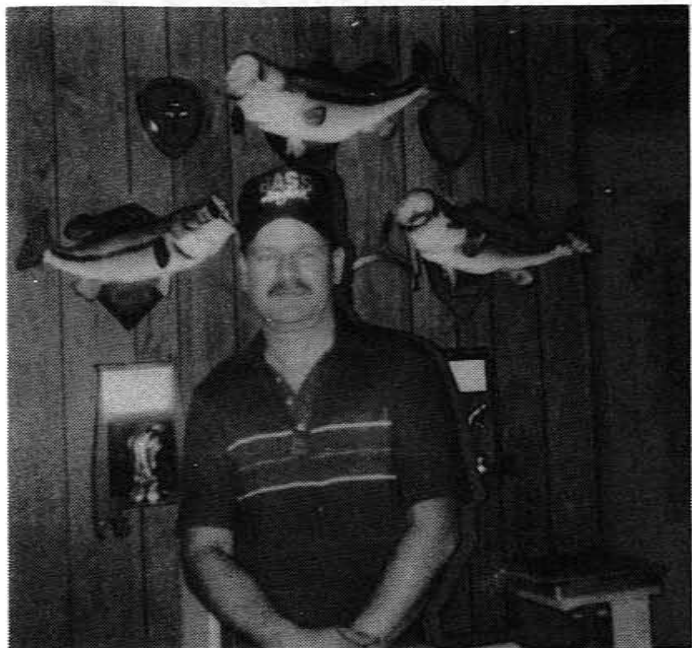

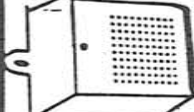
