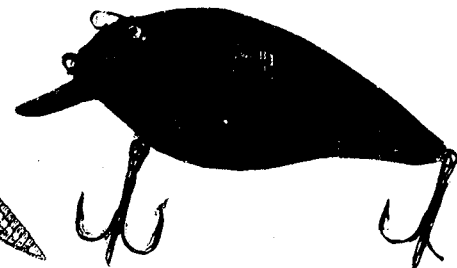
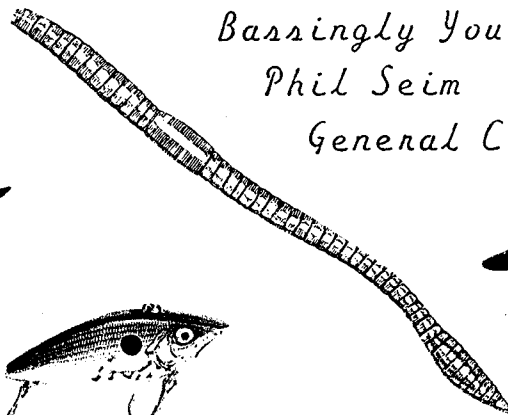
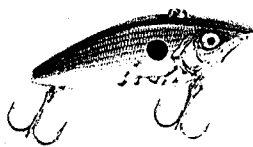
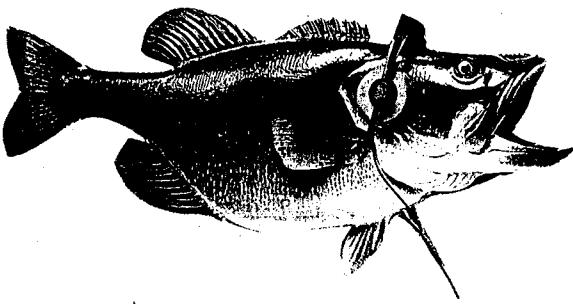


A MESSAGE FROM GENERAL CHAIRMAN

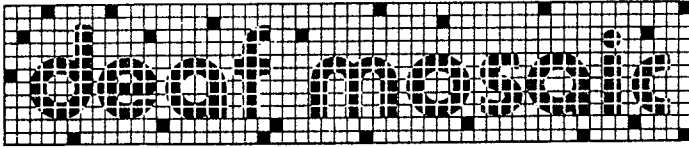
