# In Memory of Joseph O. Broz

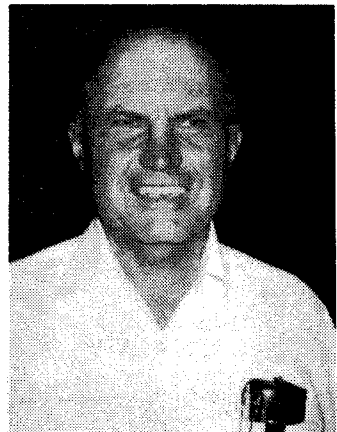
We experienced a great sorrow with the loss of Joseph O. Broz. Joseph, 68, passed away on February 20, 1992.
