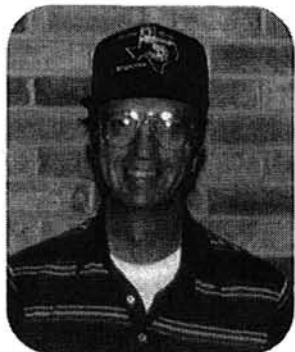

Raymond was the only one that founded two clubs in N.B.A.D. history. He just set up the club called Missouri Deaf Bass Anglers (M.D.B.A.) in 1986 and the second one called Hearing Impaired Bass Anglers Society of St. Louis (H.I.B.A.S.S.) in 1990. Both clubs are very successful.

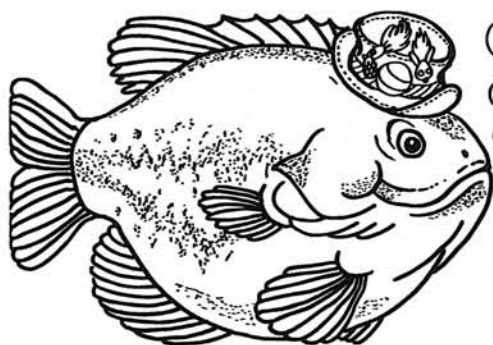
