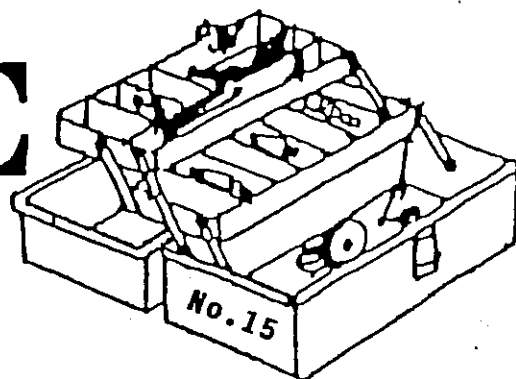




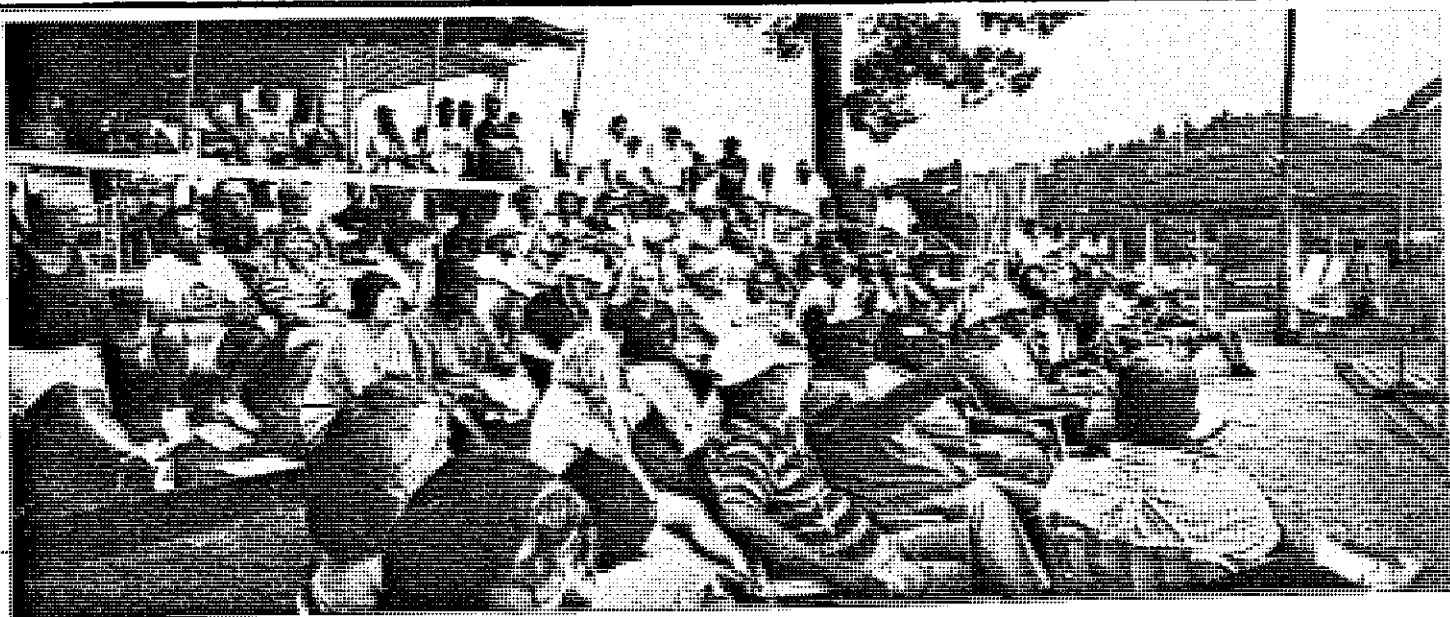

**18th Annual NBAD Team Tournament  
at Lake West Point in Georgia  
on June 15,16,17, 1993**

**Indiana Team Won  
18th Tournament Championship  
at West Piont Lake**

The 18th Annual National Bass Association of the Deaf Team Tournament was held during the second week of June directed by General Chairman Winfred Larkin and Co-Chairman Connis Collins also IBAD President Jack Stigers, at Highland Marina and Resort Located by West Piont Lake in La Grange, Georgia, Sponsored by Indiana Bass Association of the Deaf.

The new attendance record for 1993 is officially 136 anglers.

The participants represented 22 different states and there were 36 rookies competing in this tournament.

For the first time in History of NBAD an Indiana Team finally won a Championship place in NBAD's annual team tournamnet since 1976.

**PLEASE NOTE:** In history of NBAD annual tournament, it indicates that Louisiana has won the championship 8 times while Texas won 4 times Missouri won 2 times and 4 other states, Arkansas, Georgia, North Carolina and Indiana each won 1 time.

A Team consisting of Alan D. Rork and Mike Byrns, (Indiana) captured the championship place in the 18th Annual NBAD Team Tournament at West

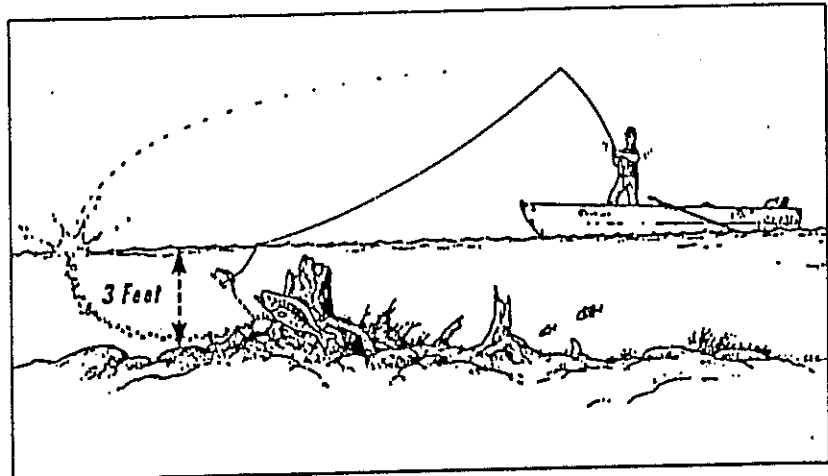

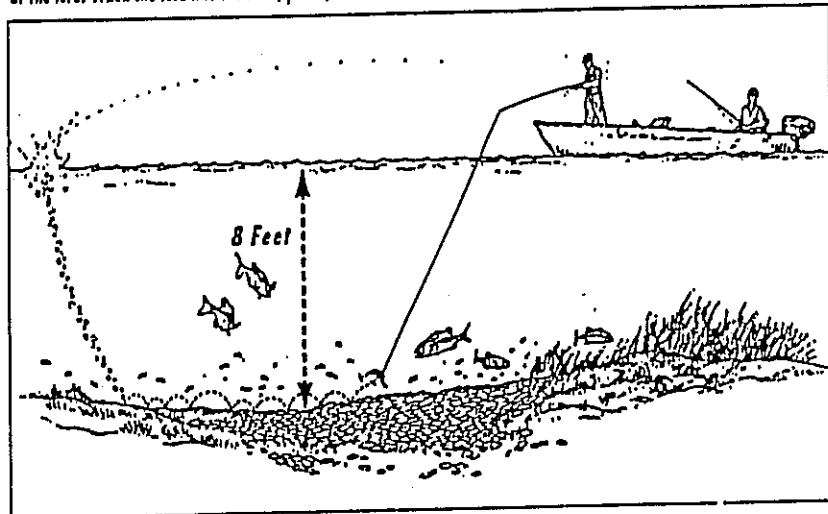

Which temperatures rise much higher than normal while the days remain sunny and bright, will warm water enough to bring deep bass more shallow. These fish will not come to the surface, but rather, suspend well above the bottom. On some lake you'll find these fish hovering close to the sunny side of rock riprap, ridge abutments, or pier pilings. The longer the weather remains warm, the more active these bass will become, so you can often fool them with a crankbait.



To master "The Collision Express" (above) cast deep-diving crankbaits beyond visible cover in shallow water, about 3 feet deep. Keep a high rod tip and retrieve fast, digging the bottom until hitting cover. Pause immediately after making contact; this is when strikes usually occur. The "Shelling Bass" tactic (below) is designed for shell beds located in shallow water, from 2 to 10 feet deep. Dredge the bottom with a medium retrieve, keeping the rod tip low and pointed at the lure. When the lure hits the beds, pause; this is when bass bite.

Point Lake at La Grange, Georgia on June 15,16,17, 1993. They brought a total of 10 bass together for 3 days which were registered at a total weight of 25.15 pounds for first place in final standing.

Second place went to a team consisting of Donald Loftin and Johnny Scott both of Georgia who caught a total of 18.09 pounds of bass.

Donald Loftin was reponaible for winning the second place. It was the fact that he caught 4 basses while his partner got only 2 basses for second place in the final standing.

Third place went to a team consisting of Dale Granger and Kevin Smith both of Louisiana Bass Association of the Deaf with a total weight of 17.21 pounds (6 basses) in final standing.

#### **HOW to CATCH or BAIT or STRIKE FINAL OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

Third place 17.21 lbs. Kevin Smith and Dale Granger went fishing on the first day, Tuesday. Dale had no luck. Kevin caught 1 bass of 4.21 pounds, where under the bridge of north. Second day, Wednesday Dale caught 1 bass of 2.46 pounds and Kevin had no luck. Third day, Thursday Dale caught 1 bass of 2.05 pounds and Kevin caught 3 basses of 8.49 pounds total weighed 10.54 pounds. Where they caught and kind lure of color used bass crankbait use 10 or 15 feet deep near buoy #88.

Second place 18.09 lbs. Donald Loftin and Johnny Scott went fishing first day, Don caught 2 bass of 3.30 pounds and Johnny caught 1 big lunker bass of 6.20 pounds. Second day, Wednesday Don caught 1 bass of 1.41 pounds and Johnny had no luck. Third day, Thursday Don caught 1 bass of 3.69 pounds and Johnny caught 1 bass of 3.49 pounds their depth finder did not work

both guessed where to go (south water of creek about 3 or 4 feet). They used lure, Junebug/shad.

First place 25.15 lbs. Alan Rork and Mike Byrns both of Indiana first day, Tuesday Alan had no luck and Mike caught 2 bass of 6.47 pounds. Second day, Wednesday Alan caught 1 bass of .75 pound and Mike had no luck. Last third day, Thursday Big Surprise Alan caught 4 bass of 11.08 pounds and Mike caught 3 bass of 6.85 pounds. They did not give up and kept on fishing in about 8 to 15 feet of more open water staying all day and it was very hot. They had to work hard fishing and sometime got tired their hands cramped. As he reels in grinds the lure into the bottom at a high speed and rams it into the backside of any cover that is capable of yielding bass.

The crankbait he used was a fat-bodied lure color of sunshine pearl blue with a bill that would have pulled it down to 8 to 15 feet deep in more open water. But the deep running crankbait made hard contact with the shell bed, arousing the bass and encouraging strikes from bigger fish. "A shallow-lipped crankbait just rides the bottom and ticks over cover like a little roller coaster". They bushes his deep-diving crankbait into the same shallow cover and catches fish that ignored the other lure. They had only one last crankbait. They don't have any other same one and sometime it stuck. They had to fight to save crankbait back and again of kept on fishing. "LUCK TEAM"

Wesley A. Parsons and Edward Bastain went out on a boat first day Saturday, July 24th. Ed caught 2 bass of weighed 3.1 pounds. He used a 5" Sidewinder Worm color of Electric Grape. Wes had no luck.

Second day Sunday, July 25th early morning, Wes and Ed went str-aight across the lake from ramp. Where Ed pointed his finger got there, until about 50 yards, along the weedline about 4 or 5 feet deep. We start Ed fishing that strike again Ed caught big bass weighing 4.9 pounds use Zara Spook color of Black and White. Wes saw where he caught it then Wes was quick fish where Ed's spot caught 1 bass of 3.2 lbs. and again second bass of 1 pound that Wes had 2 bass use buzz bait color of Chart/Lime. The 21 boats team fishing on 1993 Deafmaster Invitational at Cayuga Lake, New York weighed in 54 basses for 2 days total weight of 81.1 pounds, according Christopher Jones who is a chairman of the event, says the weather is ideal; the water temperture was 70 degree, but First day of Competition, the fishing was fair due was Blue Sky with White Cirrus Cloudy Called High Pressure. The Second day of Event, was best day "Warm Front" and the bass were active.

First day, Winner went to Paul Abbot and Jessey Mc Millian of Maryland weighed 6 pounds even for 4 basses; used 6" plastic worm worked on 6' to 10' of water in weed.

Second place Delmas Woodall and Dorian Yanke of Maryland found fish in 6' to 10' weedline; caught 3 basses for 5.4 pounds from Red Shad Worm Tube Jug.

Third place Dom Galletti and Jack Mines of New Jersey settled with 5.3 pounds for 2 basses. They used Slideworm colored Motor Oil in weedline. Also Jack Mines won his 2.14 pounds. Second Best Lunker went to Christopher, Penna bought his 2.13 pounds smallmouth bass killed the Zara Spook.

On 2 days of Compntition, **Big Surprised** 10 pounds to Wesley Parsons and Edward Bastian of New York fooled 5 basses taker to Zara Spook and Buzzbait on 1 foot of water. Edward Bastian honored his lunker weighed 4.9 pounds.

## West Point Lake Hosting Deaf Bass Anglers' Tourney

There have been no fewer fish stories at West Point Lake this week, but many of the yarns have been told in sign language.

The National Bass Fishing Association of the Deaf is holding its 18th annual tournament at Highland Marina.

Over 130 anglers from all over the United States are participating in the organization's three-day national championship. While they fish for large mouth, black and spotted bass, their families participate in recreational activities, such as the Children's Fishing Derby.

The association selected West Point Lake because "it is one of the better bass lakes in the country," according to George Marovich of Highland Marina & Resort. Next year the group will be competing at Table Rock Lake in Missouri.

Many of the participants are staying at cottages at the Marina, while others are housed at local motels. The tournament helps the local economy, as a significant amount of money is spent whenever a fishing tournament comes to town, according to Marovich.

The purpose of the tournament is to provide opportunities for deaf anglers to learn more about fish-

ing, enjoy fellowship, develop leadership and have fun, said Alan Rorke, the organization's president.

Rorke's sister, Elen Zook, is also involved in the association and the tournament. She is secretary for the National Bass Fishing Association of the Deaf and one of three women competing in the tournament.

Weigh-ins, which are open to the public, will be held today and Thursday at 3 p.m. at the Marina. Fishermen will be attempting to beat last year's record of 9.1 pounds.

Fishing skills vary from one angler to another, according to Rorke. Expert anglers as well as rookies will win awards at the Hall of Fame recognition at the end of the week. First, second and third place winners will be honored each day and over-all winners will be honored at the Hall of Fame.

Even fishermen who do not leave with prizes come away with "good memories of the tournament," concluded Rorke.

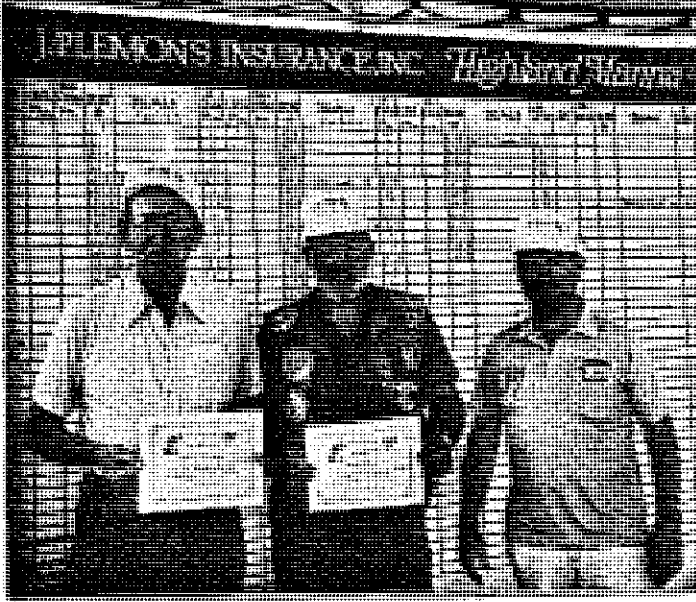

# Angler tips on how to fish weed cover

Anglers encounter weed cover in just about every body of water. But too many fishermen look at these areas and see a jungle instead of an opportunity to fish. Depending upon the body of water, weeds will hold panfish, bass, pike, muskie and, in some cases, walleye.

The deep water edges of weeds are easiest to find fish; however, casting "inside" can prove to be most effective at times. Weeds provide a security factor important to most fish. With shade from above, oxygen given off by the green weeds and apparent concealment from enemies, fish will remain in the thickest of cover. Of course, the key reason big fish are in weeds is because of the small fish that live there. When anglers determine where the bait fish live, or where big fish set up ambush for a meal, it makes catching easier.

Let's assume you want to try weed fishing next time out. Here's how to get started. First, use a heavy-action spinning or casting rod. Line should be 10 to 30 pound test. Lures are simple. For bass, use a plastic worm rigged without a slip sinker, or with a sinker just heavy enough to make casting easy. Peg the sinker to the worm head with a toothpick. Jam the toothpick into the sinker and break it off. This will keep the sinker against the worm and the bait will fall naturally into pockets.

Spinner baits or buzz baits are great. Dropped into pockets, the blades still spin as they fall. Ripped through weeds, they imitate a fleeing fish. Surface plugs such as floating minnows can be used effectively if the weeds' tops stop just below the water surface.

Several tactics can be used to catch fish out of weedy areas.

Start with a scatter-cast, covering water as thoroughly as possible using a standard, straight retrieve back to your boat. Pay particular attention to "changes" like clumps of cattails, stumps or a thicker-than-usual weed patch.

Another technique for use is fishing open pockets in the weeds. Let a spinnerbait or worm free-fall, then work it back after it hits bottom. Often times, fish will attack the lure just as it reaches the edge nearest the angler. With surface lures, be ready just as you reach the edge.

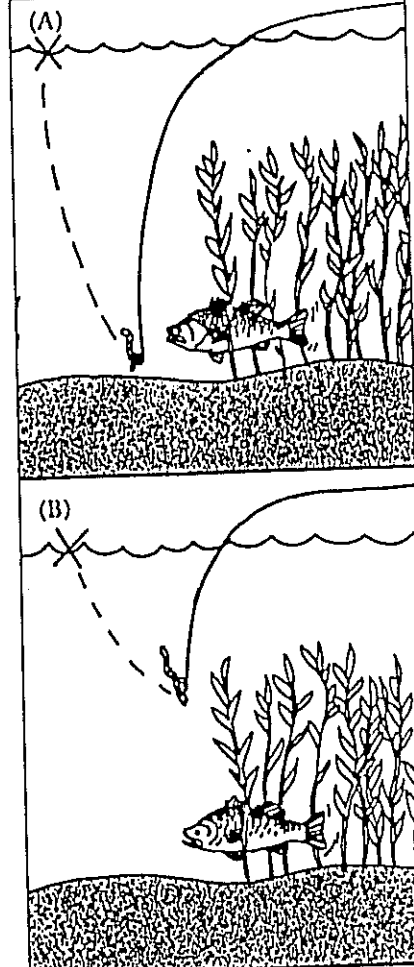
If you still don't get a strike, cast into the weeds. Fish as described above, then, at the outer edge, drop the lure or worm and work the outside into deeper water. Even though the thick weeds end, there will be bottom vegetation farther out and this can be a productive area.

Finally, move to the weed edge and try crankbaits parallel to the weeds. This can be extremely effective for walleye as they move in to feed at dusk.

Tips for fishing weeds

- Use heavier than normal tackle.
- Carry a long-handled net.
- Look for healthy, green weeds.
- Watch surface for active minnows; concentrate on fishing these areas.
- Keep an eye open for swirls and feeding fish; they usually won't move far.
- Watch your shadow and keep quiet; use electric motor, push pole or paddle.
- Use polarized glasses to spot likely looking underwater cover.
- After hooking a fish, steer it towards you and keep it coming.
- If a fish strikes behind a lure and misses, cast back right away.

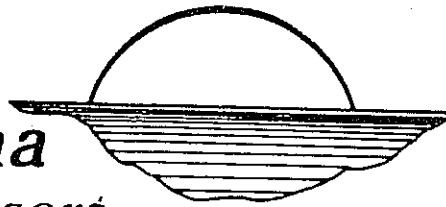
## WORMS IN WEED POCKETS

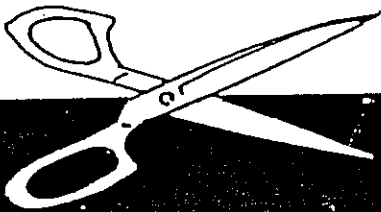

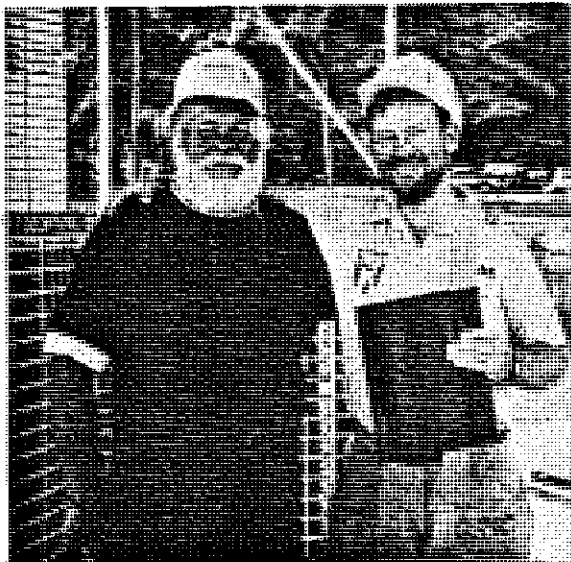
