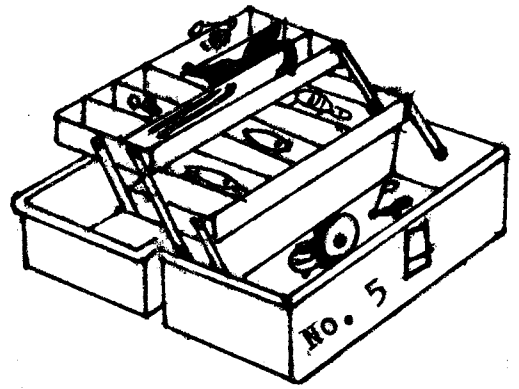

## *National Bass Association of the Deaf Team Tournament held at Eufaula, Ala.*

The 7th Annual National Bass Association of the Deaf Team Tournament was hosted by the Cave Springs Bass Club of the Deaf of Georgia at Lake Eufaula Reservoir (Walters F. George Reservoir) at Eufaula, Alabama, on June 22, 23, 24, 1982.

58 bass anglers participated in that tournament for three days. The weather was ideal for the meet, but really hot, although the anglers still caught nice sized large-mouth bass.

A team championship trophy was won by Alfred Crager and J. Mikus of Texas who collected 21 lbs. 2 oz. of basses in three days.

Cecil Koonce and Richard Lockmay of North Carolina rallied with 9 lbs 15 oz basses on the last day to capture second place after first two lousy days. It was the heaviest basses collected in one day.

The largest lunker of the tournament was registered at the scale weighing 3 lbs 11 oz which was caught on the first day of the meet. A trophy was awarded to Dale Brazzle of Baton Rouge, La., who landed his prize on plastic worm with his partner, Medford Magill of La.

A trophy for the Bassmaster of the Tournament was awarded to Alfred Crager of Texas who collected total of 14 lbs. 1 oz. of basses or more in three days.

Johnny Scott of Moreland, Ga. was awarded Sportmanship trophy for being not complaining about his damaged boat on first day of the meet. He didnot compete the rest of the tourney.

REPORT FROM OKLA. BASS ASSOCIATION of the DEAF:

Texas angler, Ronald G. Stanford of Denison, Texas, won 5th Annual Oklahoma Bass Tournament for the Deaf, Eufaula Lake, Okla., September 18 and 19, 1982.

Ron came in with 5.4 lbs. catching 2 days, and that was enough to vault over Richard Taylor of Marietta, Okla. He caught two bass only on Saturday.

Ron had a good day on Saturday and Sunday. He caught three bass in the 2 days. He did catch several bass smaller than 12 inches minimum.

However, he had to sweat out the weigh-in of the 21 anglers before he found out that his catching had won first place.

Richard Taylor held on to second place with a total of 2 pounds, 13 oz. Jerry Stroyick of Tulsa, Okla., in third place with a total of 2.8 lbs. Billy Chapman of El Reno, Okla. in fourth place with a total of 2.3 lbs. Ken Clark of Olathe, Kansas, in fifth place with a total of 2.3 lbs. Thomas Rodgers of Olathe, Kansas, in sixth place with a total of 2 lbs.

Ron continued to use a full grape 6 inches worm with long tail. He discovered bass up to 18 feet deep. He had stuck with that lure and the same fishing style the two days.

Only 16 bass were taken weighing a total of 21.4 lbs. during the two days, the weather was wind 10-15 mile per hour, chilly and rainy. This weather of acid PH was blamed by a lot of anglers for failing to do better.

Next Tournament will be at Lake Texoma, Willow Spring Resort on 70 highway in Okla., April, 1983. (Lake Texoma Invitational Bass Tournament for the Deaf).

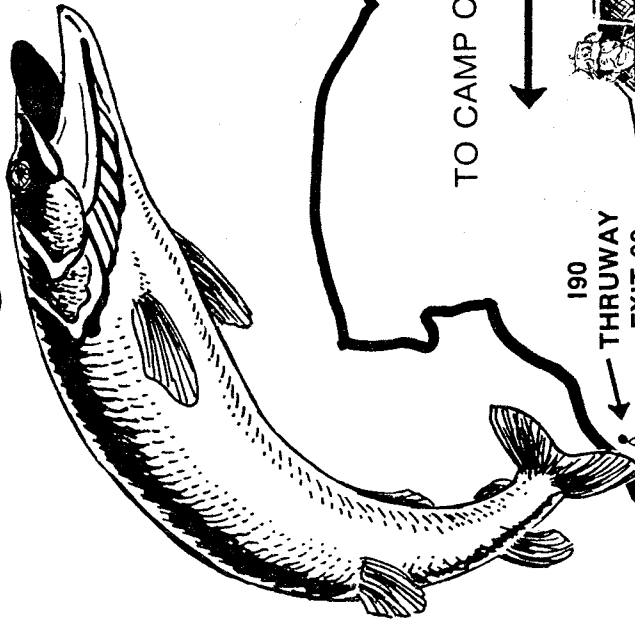

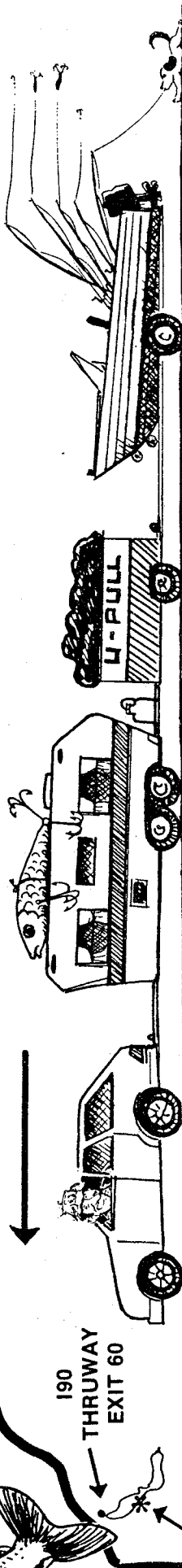

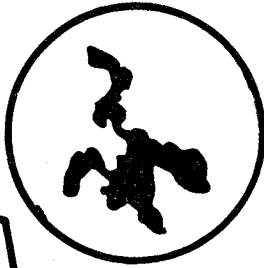
