3rd Annual Open Bass Tournament by MarVa Silent Bass Anglers Tournament Results —— September 21-22, 1996

ake Anna, the 13, 000 acre body of water located in the middle part of Virginia, was the place where 42 deaf anglers came compete in a fishing tournament during September 21-22. The weather was so nice and easily considered as the beginning of fall season. The leaves on some trees were foiling. pavilion, located in between the marina store and the 15-unit motel where deaf anglers met is close enough to the lake for a view of the bridge and the campground across the lake.

On Saturday morning, "Day One," we were ready at about 5:30 a.m. but **Bobby** Seremeth, Jr. (MD), chairperson, had boat trouble on his way to the marina from his lake house. Bobby got on his father's boat and came to the marina and let us go at about 6:00 a.m. At that time, it was dark enough with some fog on the lake so we did not have a late start as some of us thought previously.

The Day One tournament ended at 4:00 p.m. The total number of bass was sixty-one for the first day of two-day tournament. The winners for the Day One were Chris Jones and Vincent "Larry" Sabatini (PA; members of E. Penn-Jersey Club). Chris and Larry as a team brought in a total of 9.075 lbs. (see Larry's catch below)

Saturday evening, we met at the pavilion where Chris Jones and Larry Sabatini received their trophies. (see photo



They will try to get more program in the fall if they get funding for the shows for the closed-captioned. He will tell more about the closed-captioned in the NBAD Tackle Box Newsletter and Post-tournament newsletter in the future.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Secy. C. Dave Coles reported that he received three letters from three Deaf Anglers clubs and explained that he has not been contacted with NBAD officers in lately as busy with the the 1996 NBAD MDA/WDA Host committee as corresponding secretary. 


