25th ANNUAL NBAD TOURNAMENT

WELCOME to Lake Anna. Lake Anna is the second largest lake located entirely in Virginia with over 200 miles of shoreline and stretching 17 miles long. Lake Anna's setting is rural and picturesque. Situated in three central Virginia counties, the landscape is primarily farms and rolling hills.

Virginia Power purchased 18,643 acres of rural land along the North Anna and Pamunky rivers in 1968. The lake was needed to serve as a supply of cooling water for the North Anna Power Station. By 1972 the soon-to-be-lake bottom was completely cleared of all timber. A ninety-foot high dam was constructed on the North Anna river and all that was needed was more water. Based on the flow rate of the river, it was estimated that it would take three years to bring "Lake Anna" to full pool. With the help from Hurricane Agnes, the lake was at full pool in eleven months.

Now 25 years in existence, the lake continues to provide recreational opportunities for many, while maintaining a tranquil beauty. Lake Anna is really two lakes in one. The "main lake" is comprised of 9,000 acres and the "private side" is 3,400 acres. The two sides are separated by three rock dikes. The water intake is located on the main lake and the warm water discharge empties into a series of three cooling ponds which make up the private or "warm side." After the water cools, it returns to the main lake at dike three. The private side is private in the sense that there are no public boat launch facilities. Many beautiful homes adorn the serene wooded landscape on both sides.

The Department of Game and inland Fisheries manages the recreational use of the lake. The lake contains over thirty species of fish including largemouth bass, striped bass, walleye, catfish, crappie, bluegill, white and yellow perch and threadfin shad. Certain non-reproducing species of fish are restocked annually. Fishermen generally prefer the spring and fall months but also take advantage of the excellent winter fishing that Lake Anna provides.

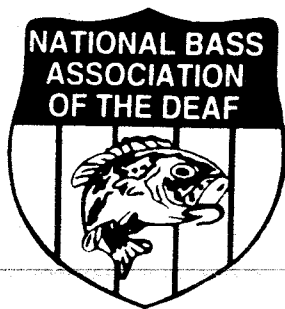

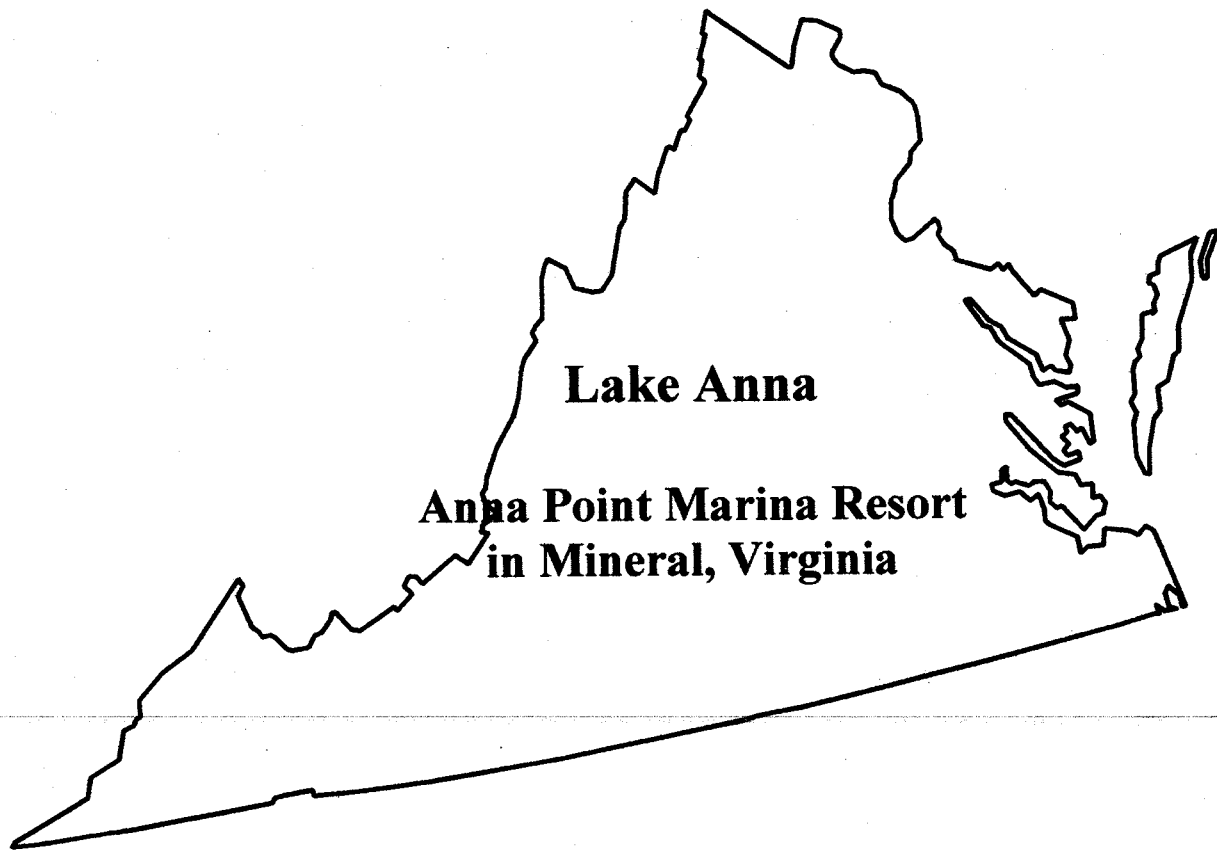

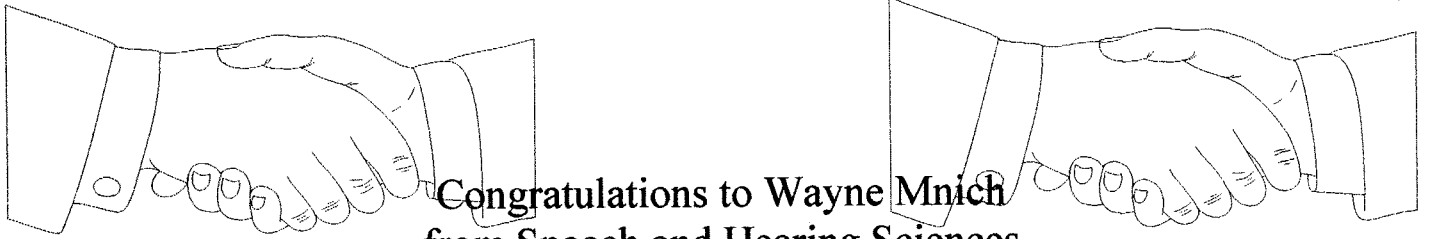

Dear Professor Mnich:

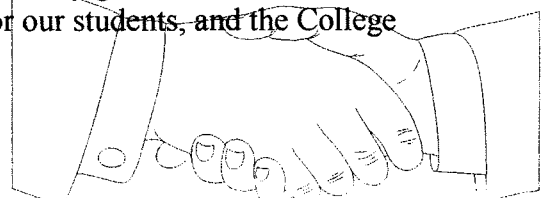
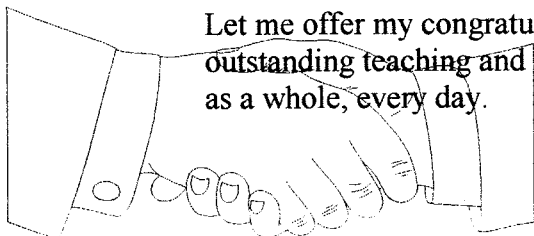
It is my great pleasure to inform you that you have been selected to receive the 2000 James Holland Award for Exemplary Teaching and Service to Students.

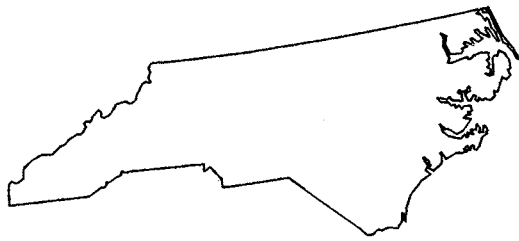

N. C. B. A. D. Annual Meeting

Members and friends of the N.C.B.A.D. had their annual meeting at the F.A.E.D. Center (Spell it backwards!) in Charlotte, NC on January 15, 2000. There were 30 people in attendance and took more than three hours to complete this very pleasant meeting.

We gave out four very special plaques before the meeting.

Tonya Prince was given a plaque honoring her for being the first female Bassin' Gal of the N.C.B.A.D. She has done very well with us for two years. She and her husband are both from South Carolina but both are members of N.C.B.A.D.

Randy Poteat was awarded the Bass Angler of the Year plaque. It is his fourth time in 25 years with N.C.B.A.D.

Steve Morris received a plaque, "The Midas Touch," for greatly improving the N.C.B.A.D. fundraising events. He has taken us out of the dark ages into the future. We owe him a great deal!

Bob Ketner was honored with a plaque naming him "The Millennium President." For the last six years he has done a lot to attract new members, improve the overall quality of N.C.B.A.D. into the 21st century. We all owe him profoundly.

After snapping many pictures, we got down to business and made the N.C.B.A.D. tourney schedule. For many years we have rewarded members 2-points bonus for every live bass brought to the scales and then released. We still do that, but this year we will penalize anglers 4 ounces for every dead bass brought to the scales. We will also penalize anglers 2 ounces for bringing "short" under-legal size bass to the scales. So it pays to be aware of these rule changes. We also have a 5-point bonus for every tourney that members participate in. We will also have a night tourney from 6 p.m. to 3 a.m. We tried this four years ago, but that time the lake was flooded with over 35 feet above normal levels, so we hope we don't have a "wash out" this time.

Again this year we voted for 13 tournaments. Twelve contests will be for points and one will be the Classic. Many will go to the Southeast Bass Assoc. of the Deaf at Lake Russell in Georgia on May 20, S.C.B.A.D. Classic at Lake Murray on May 6 and 7, and the N.B.A.D. tournament at Lake Anna in June. So that means many of us will attend 16 tournaments.

"Spank him again," the 5-year old said, "He should not have crawled in there in the first place."

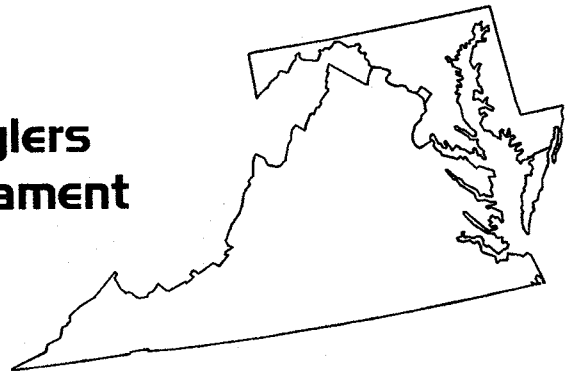

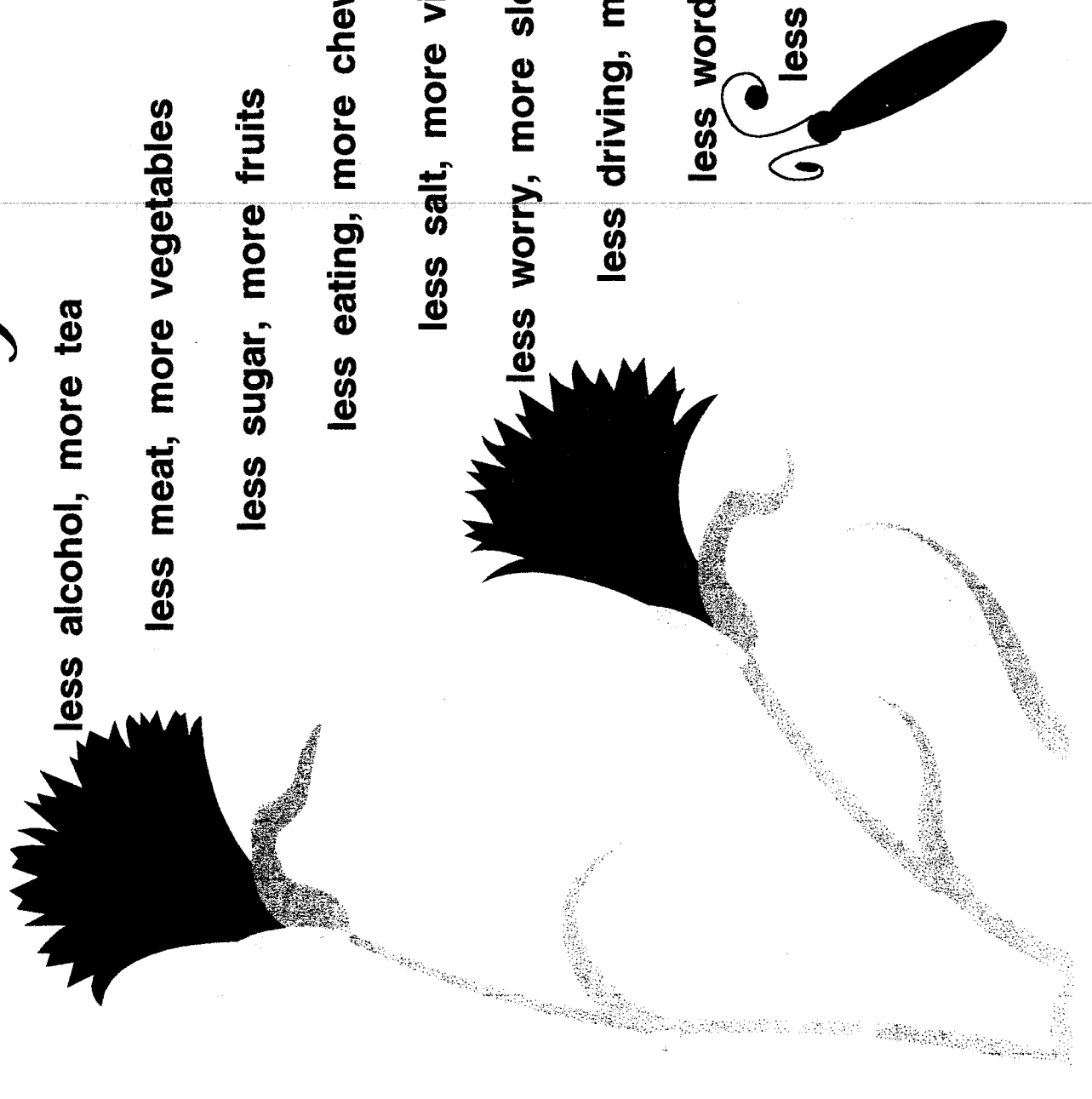

Hello Everybody,

Our beloved friend, John Lee, passed away yesterday morning at 6:45 a.m. at his home. Visitation/Wake will be held today from 5 to 8 p.m. at All Faith's Funeral Service North – 8507 North I-35 and then we will have Memorial Service for John Lee at the same place tomorrow at 11 a.m.

JAMES LEON KALINA

To James Leon Kalina, deafness was anything but a disability. The Texas School for the Deaf instructor had a passion for sports, gardening, and bass fishing that spoken words could not describe, family members said.

Kalina, 53, died Friday in a motorcycle wreck on South First Street and Barton Springs Road.

"He was proud to be deaf, and yet he was very comfortable with people that could hear," Kalina's wife, Jeanne, said Saturday. "He was able to be part of both worlds and make everyone laugh and feel loved and welcome."

Kalina was born in San Antonio and attended Sunshine Cottage and later, the Texas School for the Deaf. He went on to receive a bachelor's degree from Gallaudet University in Washington, DC, and did graduate work in deaf education at California State University of Northridge.

In 1970, Kalina began teaching at the Wisconsin School for the Deaf, returning to the Texas School for the Deaf as a teacher in 1978.

In the 22 years since then, Kalina taught a variety of subjects at the school, including woodworking, math and job skills.

"He always had a smile and a story for everybody," said Claire Bugen, superintendent of the Texas School for the Deaf. "He had a passion for fishing, and he would often see if he could get some of the kids interested in his hobby."

Kalina was active in his interests and made a difference in the deaf community, Bugen said. He was a member of the Southwestern Athletic Club for the Deaf and Austin Bass Club for the Deaf, and was secretary for the Texas Bass Club for the Deaf.

More importantly, Kalina was president of the Austin Association for the Deaf for nine years, a job he only recently retired from, his wife said.

Kalina is survived by his wife, his children Jason Leon of Colorado, Melissa Sue and Patrick Albert of Austin, and mother, Elouise Kalina, of San Antonio.

Service will be 4 p.m. Monday at Wilke-Clay-Fish Funeral Home. Instead of flowers, the family requests donations be made to the James L. Kalina Texas School for the Deaf Vocational Award Fund, in care of Wilke-Clay-Fish Funeral Home, 2620 S. Congress Ave., 78704.

Tacklebox History

The first issue of Tacklebox was published in 1978, two years after NBAD tournaments started. There was one issue published yearly until 1990 when we began publishing two issues per year.

The first two years of publication was done by Fred Murphy. Since then several people have been involved in getting the news out and recording our data for historical purposes. Those who have served as Publicity Directors besides Fred are: Medford Magill, Norman Walker, Thomas Eades, Frank Osborne, Clarence Cox, Martin Miller, Joseph Broz, Wesley Parsons, Elen Zook, Bambi St. Romain, and Wayne Mnich.

The previous issues have variety of layouts. We have interesting stories such as this one appearing in the first issue:

Medford Magill, president of NBAD, and defending champion at the recent Table Rock tournament, failed to catch a single bass over the legal 15-inch limit. So, on his way home he decided to try his luck in Black River. As he and his niece were drifting down the river and casting towards the bank with a Zara Spook plug, he hooked two (yes, TWO) bass at the same time. One weighed one pound and the other weighed three pounds. The smaller bass was hooked by the mid-section hooks and the larger bass was hooked on the rear hooks. Medford has decided to have that lure stuffed and mounted (sic).

Another story appeared in the 1981 issue:

This funny incident is true and happened at on of the Baton Rouge Deaf Bass Angler's outings. On one cool morning there were pockets of very heavy fog which limited their visibility to almost zero. A member and his partner were casting towards the bank, they drifted into one of the heaviest fogged areas, there one of the members felt a tug on his line. Assuming that it was a bass nipping on his line, he jerked his rod up hard to set the hook and started to reel it in quickly. While retrieving the tugging line, he looked up to his rod's tip, hoping that from there he would be able to trace from what direction the tugging was coming from. Upon finding the line points skyward, he started to wonder if he caught a "flying" bass. Despite of the hard tug, he kept on

retrieving until the tugging thing dropped with a big splash near his boat. That was a big flapping barn owl which looked as surprised as he was with wide eyes. Thank goodness the owl was not injured and freed itself.

We also have interesting historical data like the data for each tournament—who fished, what state they were from, how many fish caught each day and their weight recorded for each angler, who caught the lunker of the day, who come in 1st, 2nd, and 3rd each day, etc. Also we have historical data like when our local bass clubs were established. 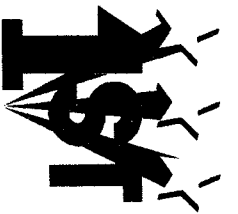

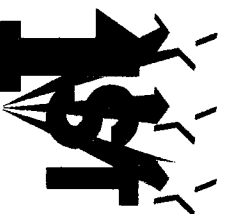

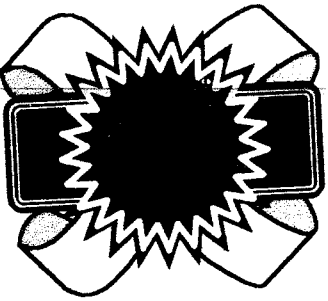
