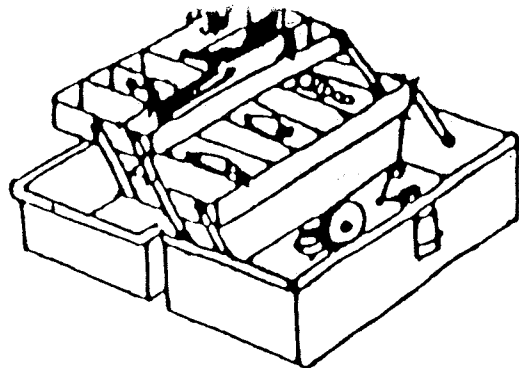

## New Record! 157 Anglers Participated in 16th Annual NBAD Team Tournament at Kentucky Lake June 11, 12, 13, 1991

The 16th Annual National Bass Association of the Deaf established a new record for attendance which has been broken fifth time since 1985.

The new attendance record for 1991 is officially 156 anglers (with one not attending) who participated in the tournament last June.

The new record broke a previous record of 128 set at Lake Barkley at Cadiz, Kentucky in 1989 which was hosted by Wisconsin Deaf Sports Club.

The participants represented 21 different states and there were 46 rookies competing in that tournament which also produced new records.

The 16th annual tournament was hosted by Dayton Deaf Anglers Club with General Chairman, Phil Seim of Ohio.

It is interesting to note that Kentucky is the only state which produced new at-

tendance records for third time since 1985.

## Georgia Team Won 16th Tournament Championship at Kentucky Lake

For the first time in history of NBAD a Georgia team finally won a championship place in NBAD's annual team tournament since 1978.

Please Note: In history of NBAD annual tournaments, it indicates that Louisiana has won the championship 8 times while Texas got 4 times and 4 other states, Arkansas, Missouri, North Carolina and Georgia each got 1 time.

A team of Ricky G. Cooper and Charles Ingram, Jr. captured the championship place in the 16th Annual NBAD Team Tournament at Kentucky Lake at Benton, Kentucky on June 11, 12, 13, 1991. They were bringing total 31 basses together for 3 days which were registered at total weight of 48.83 pounds for first place in final standing.

Second place went to a team of Ronald Smith and Judith Gaal both of Missouri Deaf Bass Anglers who caught total 41.65 pounds of bass.

Ronald was responsible for winning the second place. It was the fact that he caught 25 basses while his partner

got only 4 basses.

It is also the first time since 1979 that a team of man and woman won the second place in the final standing.

In 1979, Roger Spivey and his partner, Camille Spivey of Texas won third place in the final.

Another Missouri team of Aaron Lange and Dennis Bacon took third place with total weight of 37.47 pounds.

The largest lunker of the tournament was 6.39 pounds of bass caught by Danny K. Cochran of Tennessee who beat Charles E. Marsh, Jr. very closely. Marsh's fish weighed in at 6.34 pounds!

## Ronald Smith of Missouri Receives Bassmaster Award

The bassmaster award was presented to Ronald Smith of Russellville, Missouri who amassed 25 basses in 3 days which weighed in at total 37.37 pounds.

His total weight of bass is one of the best heaviest for bassmaster award in history. He is in second place to Gene Amons who had 44 lbs. 4 oz. at Lake Eufaula, Ok. in 1983.

Ronald is the first person from Missouri who won the bassmaster plaque in the NBAD history.

## North Carolina Angler Wins Sportsmanship Award

The NBAD really appreciates the story written by Randy N. Poteat from North Carolina who won the sportsmanship award Plaque. He is the first person from his home state to win that award in history.

Here is an article he sent us about boat and trailer troubles on trip to Kentucky Lake.

## Poteat Says "Thanks"

At our recent N.B.A.D. tourney on Kentucky Lake, I had the worst time in all my 8 tournies with the N.B.A.D.

On my way there with my wife, Tonia, I was pulling my boat when my boat trailer hit a big hole in the road in Nashville. The impact broke the U bolt holding the leaf springs and axel. As a result the left rear wheel was pushed back, onto the fender. That caused my trailer to run poorly. It looked like my trailer was going to fall off my hitch but I was stubborn and drove very slowly to Kentucky Lake. I made it but then I had to bolt my boat seats on, put trolling motor back on, put on the steering wheel and hook up all the wiring. Why did I have to do all of this at the last minute? Because I was supposed to fish in another friend's boat but he could not make it and so I just took my boat out of the "shop" and went on to Kentucky Lake. I had to work on my boat all day Saturday and Sunday. I did not get to socialize very much.

However my boat troubles were not over. On the first day of the N.B.A.D. tourney, my boat developed a leak. My partner Steve Morris found

that the water was coming in my live well but my live well had a bad crack where the water was leaking into the boat. We had to shut off the live well and keep our fish in plastic bags. As you can imagine, the bass did not live very long. By the time we checked into headquarters for weighing in our fish looked bad. It was really embarrassing for us.

Our boat almost sank one time. We really rather not talk about that.

And so for all my troubles, not being able to attend meetings and socialize, I want to thank all those who have made it possible for me to receive the sportsmanship award.

Also I would like to apologize to the many readers of the TACKLE BOX. I wrote before that I had "retired" my boat. Many of you were surprised to see me bring and work on it at Kentucky Lake.

Under the circumstances, I had no choice.

I also want to apologize for not being present at the award meeting to receive my sportsmanship award. I had to leave in a hurry after the last fishing tourney day on Thursday because I had to appear in court the next day on Friday at 9:30 a.m.

Again I want to say many thanks and see you all again next year.

## New Record for Total Bass and Weight

The 16th Annual NBAD Team Tournament produced another new record. It is about how many basses were caught by anglers at Kentucky Lake and total weight were recorded.

The new record for total basses caught for three days is 617 and total weight were

registered at 201.02 pounds.

Those records broke the previous records of 452 bass and total weight of 674.65 pounds set at Lake Barkley at Cadiz, Kentucky in 1989.

We attribute that new record to new attendance record at the same time.

128 out of 157 anglers caught bass or more for 3 days which also set a new record. The last time it was 103 out of 128 at Lake Barkley in 1989.

## Florida Won Bidding for 20th Anniversary Tournament in 1995

The Council of Representatives meeting was held on June 10, 1991 at Sportsman Lodge shelter at Kentucky Lake. Lake Okeechobee in Florida was voted for the best place for 20th Annual NBAD Team Tournament for June 11-15, 1995. The headquarters will be located at Roland Martin's Marina.

Wayne O. Mart of Lakeland, Florida will be a general chairman of that anniversary tournament who was selected at the meeting.

## New Record: 18 Teams Caught 20 lbs. & Over for 3 Days

When the 16th annual tournament was over, the NBAD learned that it had 18 teams which caught 20 pounds and over for 3 days.

As a result it sets a new record which broke the previous record of 9 teams that caught 20 pounds or over in 1989 at Lake Barkley at Cadiz, Kentucky.

The 16th annual NBAD Team Tournament produced a new record by having 12 anglers who caught 10 pounds of bass in one day at Kentucky Lake this summer. The new record erased the old record of 11 anglers caught 10 pounds of bass in one day at Lake Eufaula in Oklahoma in 1983.

## Only 2 Anglers Who Caught 10 lbs. & Over Each Day for 3 Days Since 1976

The NBAD has a pleasure to report that it finally has only two anglers who have caught 10 pounds and over each day for 3 days in one of the tournaments since 1976.

They are: Gene Amons from Louisiana who amassed 44 lbs 4 oz in 1983 at Lake Eufaula in Oklahoma and Ronald Smith from Missouri had 37.37 lbs. at Kentucky Lake in 1991.

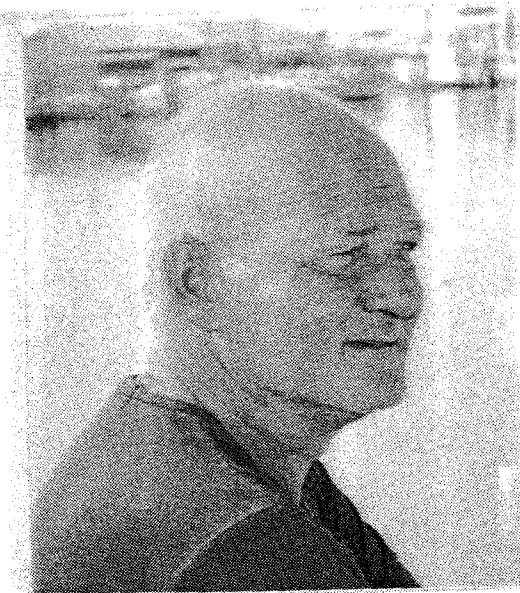
Marsh of Olathe at 1-pound, 12-ounces and Harley Holmes of Olathe at 1-pound, 9-ounces.

"You've got a deal," the owner replied.

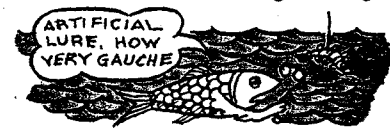
Thinking he had the owner where he wanted him, the art collector then said "Since the kitten likes milk so much, why don't you throw in the saucer too?"
