The 1996 NBAD CHAMPION are Ron Smith and Kenneth Kistner, the total weight of bass they caught were 56.10 lbs., and pocketed \$3,000 back home with them. Congratulations to them.

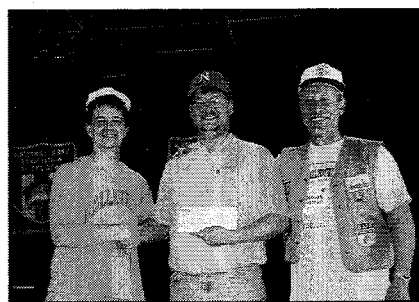

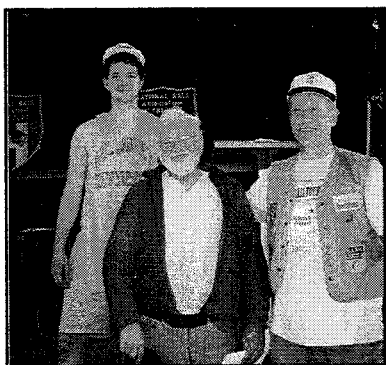

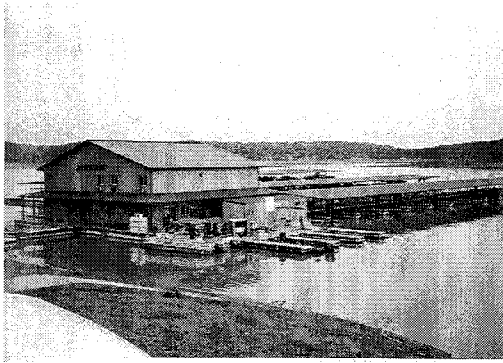
